Frequenta a New York la Parsons School . scuola d'arte per arredatori, illustratori, grafici e modellisti – e successivamente la Moses Soyer Art School, una piccolo scuola di pittura.

Dopo la guerra si trasferisce a Parigi dove dipinge ed espone i suoi quadri. Arriva più tardi in Italia, a Milano, dove inizia a disegnare tessuti dai caratteristici motivi floreali.

He attended the New York Parsons School – which held courses in decoration, illustration, graphics and dressmaking – and subsequently the Moses Soyer Art School, a small school of painting.

After the Second World War he moved to Paris where he painted and exhibited his works.

He next moved to Milan, Italy, where he began dyeing fabrics; all his fabrics bear the characteristic floral motif.
