VENINI's colours are part of an ancient cultural heritage. Each colour is composed by a specific and secret recipe. VENINI's colour palette includes a great variety of shades which are constantly expanding and evolving. Pagliesco (Straw-yellow), Verde Mela (Apple-Green), Orizzonte (Horizon), Acquamare (Aquamarine), Viola (Violet), and Giallo (Yellow), Rosa Cipria (Cipria Pink) and Rosso Sangue di Bue (Oxblood red) are just an insight into the secret world of VENINI's colours.





VENINI has always stood out for its intriguing and alternative approach to Murano's artistic glass traditions.

The VENINI glassworks have their own "Genius Loci" which inspire a fascinating way of discovering glass and glassmaking.

Each object is handmade by master glassmakers and is the result of ancient and precious centuries-old techniques.












Techniques

VENINI's own museum contains 45,000 drawings, 10,000 vintage photos and 4,000 works of art, making it the most precious historical archive of modern and contemporary glass art in the world.

Art gallery and Collectors

VENINI has always created artworks with a timeless design which are destined to increase in value. Thanks to the excellence of quality, the high artistic content and the manufacturing value intrinsic to each artwork, the hammer prices of VENINI glassware reach record figures at major auctions; in fact, the highest price ever paid for a Murano artwork was for a VENINI masterpiece: "La Sentinella di Venezia" of 1962 which fetched 737 thousand US dollars.

At the occasion of the centenary of the historic VENINI furnace, the Ministry of Economic Development has issued an exclusive postage stamp as part of the thematic series

"The Excellence of the Economic and Productive System".

The initiative is a valuable recognition of the role that Venini continues to play in the Italian economic landscape and in the international promotion of Italian-made products.

The coveted postage stamp, created by Gaetano leluzzo, shows an illustration of the "Fazzoletto" vase, one of VENINI's iconic pieces: hand-blown and hand-crafted in Murano glass, it was conceived in 1948 by Fulvio Bianconi and Paolo Venini. As a favourite of design enthusiasts, it is on display in numerous museums around the world (including the New York Museum of Modern Art). Reproduced in the background of the image is the historical drawing of the work preserved in the Venini Museum in Murano.

2021 **TRICOLORE FAZZOLETTO**«QUIRINALE CONTEMPORANEO»

The iconic «Fazzoletto» by Fulvio Bianconi and Paolo Venini designed in 1948 has been redesigned for the centenary and for the Quirinale. This exclusive creation, which takes the name of Fazzoletto Tricolore, is dedicated to the 160th anniversary of the unification of Italy and realized with the technique of «Canne»: handmade stripes of red, green and crystal coloured glass.





The VENINI artworks are exhibited at the Palazzo del Quirinale: VENINI is in fact the protagonist of the "Quirinale Contemporaneo" project. The "Quirinale Contemporaneo" project aims to update the image of institutional offices by inserting relevant expressions of the genius and inspiration of Italian artists, from the birth of the Republic to the present day: works of art and design objects that add an important public testimony of Italian excellence in this sector, never weakened. Inside the Quirinale there are many VENINI creations that have been selected for their inestimable symbolic value in reference to the history of art and design.
